


# Main Issues of ENGOs in Japan

- · Weak ability to make a policy proposal
- Tend to stand to their own opinion
- → Other NGOs, businesses and public administrations request them to collaborate.
- → It is not certain if they are prepared to accept such a request








## Setting a Platform for Sustainable Community-building in Onuma



2009年からESD連続セミナーなどを(財)北海道国際交流センター(HIF)とともに開催し、意識醸成を図った。2010年にはCOP10のサイドイベントへ協働出展し、大沼の現状を多くの人に周知するため全国へ向けて発信した。2011年にはラムサール条約登録湿地候補地に選定され、2012年6月には大沼ラムサール協議会が発足し、ラムサールをテーマに関係者が集まる場を創出した。


To gain understanding and support from relevant parties involved in the district, in 2009, EPO Hokkaido held a series of ESD seminars in Onuma as well as seminars on sustainability in partnership with Hokkaido International Foundation(HIF). In 2010, EPO Hokkaido made a collaborative presentation display at COP10's side event to report on the current status of Onuma. In 2011, Onuma was selected as a candidate site for a registered wetland under the Ramsar Convention and EPO Hokkaido organized a study group in Nanae Town about the Ramsar Convention. In June that year, the Onuma Ramsar Convention was established as a place for stakeholders to come together to discuss the Ramsar Convention.

## 「郷土(ふるさと)の森づくり」事業

Reforestation in the Home Lan

EPO中部が主催した環境報告書を読む会に、中日本高速道路㈱が参加し、郷土種子を活用した植樹、生物多様性保全の問題意識が高まった。EPO中部では企業の環境技術、地域の森づくり活動、行政施策をコラボレーションさせ、地域課題の解決につなげるようとした。

A local company managing highways joined the meeting organized by Chubu Environmental Partnership Office (EPO Chubu) to review environmental reports. They walked away with an enhanced understanding of the need to use local seeds for planting trees, protecting biodiversity and expanding the ratio of green space in the city. EPO Chubu's aim was to bring businesses' environmental technologies, local forestry activities and the government's strategies together to collaborate and work toward resolving local issues.
