Phase I EIA

Prepare an environmental
impact statement

EIA Review Committee
reviews the EIS

Publish the
conclusions related
to the EIS review

Explanatory
meeting

Projects or activities are likely to
have significant adverse impacts
on the environment

Phase II EIA

the Process of Phase II EIA



Display or disclose the EIS, etc.

public meeting

opinions from residents

Invite the non-governmental groups and the representatives of local residents for scoping

Scoping

Prepare a draft EIA Report

Conduct an on-site inspection and hold a public hearing

Invite the non-governmental groups and local residents to participate

EIA Review Committee reviews the draft EIA report

non-governmental groups and local residents can apply to attend the meeting

Complete the EIA Report

The items(alternate plans, etc.) before preparing the environmental impact statement. 3. The environmental impact statement and the draft EIA report 4.
