## The New changes on Environmental Impact Assessment of China

## Abstract

In recent years, with the revision of Environmental Protection Law and Environmental Impact Assessment Law, the environmental impact assessment system of China has begun to appear a relatively big innovation. These revisions are highlighted in the following ways: 1. the "Supervisory Management" had been strengthened and the environmental impact assessment must be carried out for the preparation of planning and construction projects; 2. the content of environmental information disclosure and public participation had been established; 3. the legal liability for violating the basic requirements of environmental impact assessment is specified in the law; 4. the relevant items of administrative review and approval have been deleted but the post-event supervision has been strengthened.

This slides want to show all these reform based on three aspects: 1.1.Recent system innovations of environmental impact assessment in China: 2. Supervision for Environmental Protection in the practice level; 3.a case study about the environmental interest.
